NEWSREADER: A group representing Aboriginal traditional owners of Kakadu National Park says they doubt production at the Ranger uranium mine will be able to resume this year.

The Energy Resources of Australia Ranger mine suspended production in January after heavy rain brought its tailings dam close to overflowing.

The science officer for the Gundjeihmi Aboriginal Corporation, Geoff Kyle, says the rain has also partly-filled the mine's operating pit, which will take months to clear.

GEOFF KYLE: The facts are that the pit's already got a big mob of water in it, and I can't see Ranger getting started again this year. I might be wrong, but looking at it, the situation, I don't see how they can do it.
